Choose a focus from one of the following policy areas:

PAX Next Steps: PBIS / Multi-tiered System of Supports

This training demonstrates how to integrate PAX strategies into schoolwide PBIS and MTSS initiatives including how to use PAX Kernels as tiered support.

PAX Next Steps: Trauma-informed Classrooms/ Social-Emotional Learning

This training demonstrates how the nurturing environment created by PAX strategies also ensures a trauma-informed classroom and improves children's social-emotional learning.



About PAX Next Steps Trainings

PAX Next Steps Trainings consist of 6 content hours and include in-depth explorations of the eleven evidence-based strategies that make up the PAX Good Behavior Game through the lens of the selected training content area.
